Louie's Grounded Sohrab Uduman

Louie's Grounded was given its first performance by OPUS 20 in St. John's Smith Square in October 1993 in a concert promoted by the Society for the Promotion of New Music, SPNM. In 1994 the SPNM awarded Uduman the George Butterworth prize for Louie's Grounded.

In *Louie's Grounded* a recurring musical idea forms the basis for the overall shape of the work. A musical line, melody, drawn out of the basic material creates a landscape which is traversed a number of times. On each successive appearance the line progressively begins to take flight until the final presentation, which fragments and disperses the characters of the melody. Louie's Grounded is dedicated to Nick Virgo.
